

Hours of work at Torquay Academy: 17 hours a week

Responsible to: Principal through Director of Football

This job description is not a comprehensive definition of the post. Discussions will take place on a regular basis to clarify individual responsibilities within the general framework and character of the post as identified below

The duties of the Football Coach at Torquay Academy include the following:

- Lead/Assist with the planning and preparing of football coaching sessions.
- Lead/Assist with training sessions and management on game days.
- Carry out player tests, for the students assigned to him/her, including the collating and recording of data.
- Assisting with the assessing, recording and reporting on the development and progress of football development students.
- Organise and set up equipment, develop strategies and practices and implement them during training sessions.
- Using available GPS technology monitor players during practice sessions to identify strengths and areas of improvement for players and give timely feedback to students.
- Follow the Team TA syllabus and produce match and player reports when needed.
- Using the NACSport analysis software support in developing a program to enhance the learning of the players.
- Assist with developing and implementing weekly year 7-11 football practice schedules as part of planning strategy. (School teams)
 - Collaborate with teams during games to provide necessary guidance and support.
- Produce feedback to Director of football along with admin duties for player meetings. Participate in special events in addition to usual games and practices as required.
- Enforces discipline policies and emphasise sportsmanship and healthy lifestyles.
- Maintains a safe environment and facilities for students at all times.
- Ensures that Academy medical and health and safety requirements are followed. Professionally represent the Academy in interactions with students, parents, and other teams.
